Program Description: Point-of-Care ultrasound has been shown to facilitate vascular access, determine aspiration risk, confirm endotracheal tube placement, assess pulmonary function, and evaluate fluid-volume volume status. Through the AANA, a collaborative group of instructors coordinated by the Middle Tennessee School of Anesthesia (MTSA) will provide a hybrid course that combines online modules with a hands-on workshop.

Program Description: The program is an intensive four-hour course combining didactic and hands-on training emphasizing skill demonstration, feedback, and instruction.
